- Subchapter 1: Types of Medical Marijuana Identification Cards and Fees Associated
  - Patient Identification Cards
    - ▶ \$50.00 fee with exceptions
      - ► SNAP, TanF, WIC program participants, fee reduced to \$25.00
  - Caregiver Identification Cards
    - ▶ \$50.00 with exceptions
      - ► SNAP, TanF, WIC program participants, fee reduced to \$25.00
  - Physician Identification Cards
    - ▶ \$50.00 fee

- Subchapter 2: Identification Cards, General
  - Valid for one year after application criteria is met.
    - ► Includes physician certification
- Subchapter 3: Patient Application
  - ▶ Legal name and any aliases
  - Date of Birth
  - Physical Address
  - Telephone number and email address
  - Photograph: MS Driver's License or State Issued ID
  - ► Physician Certification
  - Application Fee
  - ▶ Parental/Legal Guardian Consent for Minors (under age 18)

- Subchapter 4: Caregiver application
  - ► Caregivers assist qualified patients with use of medical marijuana
- ► Subchapters 5 & 6: Caregiver Institution/Program and Application
  - ► Hospice, hospitals, assisted living programs, IDF/IDD programs
  - Allows employees to serve as caregivers for residents who might be patients of the medical marijuana program

- Subchapter 7: Physician Certification
  - Certification of the debilitating medical condition after a face-to-face visit with the applicant
  - Issued for twelve months or less
- Subchapter 8: Physician Identification Cards & Application
  - Physicians providing certification of debilitating conditions must obtain an identification card
  - Application process
    - Evidence of unrestricted medical license in MS
    - Physical address of practice
    - ► Evidence of completion of CME requirements
    - ► Authorization for the Department to communicate with the Board of Medical Licensure
    - ▶ Disclosure of relationships/interest to any licensed entities

- Subchapter 9: Requirements for Physicians
  - ► Initial and ongoing CME requirements specific to medical marijuana approved by the Department
  - Physician certification to treat a condition within the physician's area of specialty
  - ► Freedom of choice for patients to select medical marijuana treatment centers/dispensaries
  - ► Adherence to the rules, regulations, and policies of the Board of Medical Licensure inclusive of Part 2640: Chapter 1—Rules pertaining to prescribing, administering, and dispensing medication
